The prestigious 41°-74° Club of New York is one of the oldest travel organizations in the New York Metropolitan area and has been in existence for nearly 90 years

The objectives of the Club are social, educational, and philanthropic. Members enjoy networking at the several meetings scheduled during the Club year. Meetings may include guest speakers presenting issues of interest to the membership or showcase a special and specific destination or product. Twice each year, the Club raises funds to support one or more worthy charities designated by the membership, usually those that focus on helping women or children of need in the New York metropolitan area.

Membership is by invitation only. A prospective member must be sponsored by two active members who must have been members in good standing for at least twelve months.

The requirements to become a member of the Club are as follows:

- A prospective member must have been employed in the sales or promotion of passenger travel for at least three continuous years prior to applying for membership, one of which must be in the New York area.
- She must complete a membership application form online. The completed form must include the names of two sponsors who are active club members.
- Payment of an initiation fee is required with the completed application. Payment may be made online by credit card.

Upon completion of the above requirements, the application is first reviewed by the Membership Committee and then presented to the Board of Director of the Club for approval.

Following approval by the Board of Directors and payment of the applicable annual dues, the Prospective Member is introduced to the membership at the next club meeting and inducted into the club. New members accepted between July 1st and January 31st shall pay the initiation fee of \$50 and the full amount of dues \$110. New members accepted between February 1st and June 30th shall pay the full initiation fee of \$50 and one-half the annual dues \$55. Membership commences upon receipt of dues.

All active members must attend a minimum of two meetings during each club year to maintain good standing.
